



Trader's Agreement #2023 1186

BETWEEN Dee Handyside Music 24 265 072 546 hereinafter referred to as the Fundraiser, and the Australian Cancer Research Foundation ABN 27 076 461 360, hereinafter referred to as ACRF.

RECITAL:

ACRF will be a beneficiary of proceeds raised by Dee Handyside Music during the months of February 2023 – February 2024. ACRF will receive \$19.03 per \$50 sale of the individual & group Host at Home Kits, or 38% of gross proceeds of each sale by Dee Handyside Music through the Silk Rags Project after referred to as Appeal. Silk Rags Project will be operating at https://www.thesilkragsproject.com/.

CONDITIONS TO BE OBSERVED IN CONDUCTING THE APPEAL

1. Appeal to be conducted in compliance with the law

The Fundraiser agrees to comply with the provisions of the Charitable Fundraising Act 1991, (NSW) and with regulations made under the Act.

Period of appeal

- a) The appeal will commence from 1 February 2023 and end on 1 February 2024. Should both parties agree, the Agreement will be extended for a further term.
- b) This Agreement ends in accordance with clause 12 below.

3. **Expenses**

The Fundraiser will bear all expenses incurred in the course of organising and conducting the appeal.

Payment of money raised by the appeal

- a) Donations will be calculated on a **quarterly basis**. In the final week of each quarter the *Fundraiser* agrees to send ACRF a statement outlining sales for the previous quarter and the amount representing ACRF's share of those sales.
- b) At the same time, payment of funds raised during the specified period will be made by cheque or electronic funds transfer to ACRF.

5. Inspection of Records

- a) The Fundraiser agrees to allow ACRF to inspect, audit and make copies of any records of account relating to the conduct of the fundraising appeal. In doing so, ACRF must comply with privacy laws and not disclose any confidential information regarding the business.
- b) If ACRF wishes to make such an inspection, it is required to provide the Fundraiser reasonable notice to conduct the inspection during normal business hours

6. Advertising

The format and content of all advertising, notices and information to be published in relation to the appeal will be submitted to ACRF for approval prior to publication.

Licence to use Charity Logo

- a) For Australia, ACRF grants the Fundraiser a non-exclusive, non-transferable revocable licence to use the approved Proudly Backing ACRF logo and trademark in relation to the appeal.
- b) The Proudly Backing ACRF logo is the whole of the logo including the words and the crab graphic device which is the trademark of ACRF. The logo will not be altered or adjusted in any way and will be accompanied by the following words, or similar: "The Fundraiser proudly supports Australian Cancer Research Foundation" on any hard copy and or digital material sent out by the Fundraiser which carries the Proudly Backing ACRF logo.
- c) The Fundraiser must submit, for ACRF's prior approval, any use which the Fundraiser propose to make of the Proudly Backing ACRF logo. Unless revoked earlier, this licence to use the ACRF logo and trademark will terminate at the end of the appeal.

8. Standards and Responsibilities

The Fundraiser agrees to:

- a) Make no written or oral statements regarding this fundraising appeal which are known or could reasonably be expected to be known to be false or misleading;
- b) Provide proof of the authority provided by *ACRF* to the *Fundraiser* on request from participating customers (e.g. this Trader's Agreement);
- c) Provide high quality products and service at all times and to strive to inspire and sustain consumer confidence;
- d) Maintain the highest standards of safety;
- e) Not engage in any form of selling, promotion, operation, advertising, publicity or other activity likely to bring *ACRF* into disrepute.
- f) On cessation of the appeal, promptly withdraw from the marketplace any and all materials bearing the logo and name of *ACRF*.
- g) At all times act in good faith and promote its relationship with ACRF in a professional manner.

9. Indemnity

The *Fundraiser* agrees to indemnify *ACRF* against damages, expenses, losses or liabilities suffered or incurred by *ACRF* at any time as a result of any misconduct by the *Fundraiser* during the appeal.

10. Insurance

ACRF does not provide insurance cover for any *Fundraiser*. In signing below the *fundraiser* confirms that insurance cover has been or will be obtained by them if relevant to the fundraising appeal.

The Fundraiser agrees to effect public liability, product liability & professional indemnity insurance and any other type of insurance which *ACRF* may reasonably request.

12 **Termination**

- a) This agreement will end once all monies raised by the appeal have been paid to ACRF and all records of income and expenditure in relation to the appeal have been provided to ACRF.
- b) ACRF reserves the right to terminate this agreement and the appeal at any time if ACRF is of the opinion that the appeal is not being conducted lawfully or that the Fundraiser is in breach of this agreement or that allowing the appeal to continue may damage the image or goodwill of ACRF.
- c) The Fundraiser may terminate this agreement by giving one month's notice in writing to ACRF of the Fundraisers intention to cease operating the appeal. All monies raised on behalf of ACRF up to and including the date of termination will be paid to ACRF within fifteen (15) days of the date of termination.

Resolution of disputes and complaints

If it appears to ACRF to be necessary, ACRF will convene a disputes committee consisting of one representative of each party and determine in accordance with the principles of natural justice any complaint from the public or any grievance expressed by an employee of either party in relation to the conduct of the appeal.

Variation of these conditions

ACRF may vary these conditions by written notice to the Fundraiser if this becomes necessary to ensure compliance with the relevant laws or the conditions of the Act. No other variation of these conditions will be effective unless in writing and signed by both parties.

15. **Governing Law**

The laws of New South Wales govern this agreement and each party irrevocably submits to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of New South Wales and to all courts of appeal there from.
