CONDITIONS TO BE OBSERVED IN CONDUCTING THE APPEAL

1.Appeal to be conducted in compliance with the law

The Fundraiser agrees to comply with the provisions of the Charitable Fundraising Act 1991, (NSW) and with regulations made under the Act.

2. Period of appeal

- a. The appeal will commence from **1 November 2025** and end on **31 October 2026**. Should both parties agree, the Agreement will be extended for a further 12-month term.
- b. This Agreement ends in accordance with clause 12 below.

3. Expenses

The Fundraiser will bear all expenses incurred in the course of organising and conducting the appeal.

4. Payment of money raised by the appeal

- a. Donations will be calculated on a **quarterly basis**. In the final week of each quarter the *Fundraiser agrees to send ACRF* a statement outlining sales for the previous quarter and the amount representing *ACRF*'s share of those sales.
- b. At the same time, payment of funds raised during the specified period will be made by cheque or electronic funds transfer to *ACRF*.

5. Inspection of Records

- a. The *Fundraiser* agrees to allow *ACRF* to inspect, audit and make copies of any records of account relating to the conduct of the fundraising appeal. In doing so, *ACRF* must comply with privacy laws and not disclose any confidential information regarding the business.
- b. If *ACRF* wishes to make such an inspection, it is required to provide the *Fundraiser* reasonable notice to conduct the inspection during normal business hours
- c. The *Fundraiser* undertakes to *ACRF* that all financial dealings by the *Fundraiser* will be held in the most honest and agreeable fashion, but if for any reason an audit finds that money raised on behalf of *ACRF* has not been paid, the *Fundraiser* will promptly forward the deficiency and pay all reasonable costs incurred in the audit.

6. Advertising

The format and content of all advertising, notices and information to be published in relation to the appeal will be submitted to *ACRF* for approval prior to publication.

7. Licence to use Charity Logo

a. For Australia, ACRF grants the Fundraiser a non-exclusive, non-transferable revocable licence to use the approved Proudly Supporting ACRF logo and trademark in relation to the appeal.

12. Termination

- a. This agreement will end once all monies raised by the appeal have been paid to ACRF and all records of income and expenditure in relation to the appeal have been provided to ACRF.
- b. ACRF reserves the right to terminate this agreement and the appeal at any time if ACRF is of the opinion that the appeal is not being conducted lawfully or that the Fundraiser is in breach of this agreement or that allowing the appeal to continue may damage the image or goodwill of ACRF.
- c. The Fundraiser may terminate this agreement by giving one month's notice in writing to ACRF of the Fundraisers intention to cease operating the appeal. All monies raised on behalf of ACRF up to and including the date of termination will be paid to ACRF within fifteen (15) days of the date of termination.

13. Resolution of disputes and complaints

If it appears to ACRF to be necessary, ACRF will convene a disputes committee consisting of one representative of each party and determine in accordance with the principles of natural justice any complaint from the public or any grievance expressed by an employee of either party in relation to the conduct of the appeal.

14. Variation of these conditions

ACRF may vary these conditions by written notice to the Fundraiser if this becomes necessary to ensure compliance with the relevant laws or the conditions of the Act. No other variation of these conditions will be effective unless in writing and signed by both parties.

15. Governing Law

The laws of New South Wales govern this agreement, and each party irrevocably submits to the nonexclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of New South Wales and to all courts of appeal there from.

The Fundraiser agrees to comply with the above conditions.
